#### The Power of Forgiveness

The most powerful thing one person can say is, "I was wrong, will you forgive me." One of the most healing things a person can do is to forgive a wrong. "I Forgive you" are impact-filled words. They overcome fear and worry, they set aside hurts and they are liberating in their effect.

Did you know that we are built to forgive? We are; but over time, we become cynical and jaded toward forgiveness. We even become bitter toward the one(s) who have hurt us and we refuse to forgive. Usually, its because we have been hurt by the same person or people repeatedly. Peter asked the Lord one day, "how many times should I forgive someone who has trespassed against me; seven times?" The Lord's reply was, "until seventy times seven..." As incredible as that may seem, God expects us to forgive like he forgives. Matthew 6:14–15 <sup>14</sup> For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. <sup>15</sup> But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions."

Forgiveness is not ignorance of what has happened to us, rather it is an intentional decision to not bring a wrong back up. When the Lord promises to "cast our iniquities into the sea ..." Micah 7:18-19 or to remove our sins from us "as far as the east is from the west ..." Ps. 103:11, he is offering to us a pattern that Jesus will personify. Forgiveness is bound up in the heart and nature of God. He makes an intentional decision to overlook our wrongs toward him, when we admit that we have been wrong, that we have sinned against him and we deliberately turn from the wrong to follow after him. Even if it takes us four hundred ninety times to get it right, he will forgive us every time and we should forgive others as well. We should all become expert at forgiving, it is a life long discipline that honors God.

Here are ten reasons that forgiveness is not only necessary but good for you:

- 1. Forgiveness goes against our human nature
- 2. Unforgiveness keeps us locked in the pain someone else caused
- 3. Unforgiveness is passed from generation to generation
- 4. Unforgiveness tends to lead to revenge
- 5. Forgiveness is beyond fairness
- 6. Forgiveness does not minimize the offense
- 7. Forgiveness requires time and maturity
- 8. Forgiveness does not absolve the offender of the consequence of his offense
- 9. Forgiveness speaks to the longing of every human heart
- Learning to bless those who offend you and overlook the hurt means you are moving in the right direction

God bless you as you learn to practice forgiveness.
